

ZOO TO OPEN ART EXHIBIT

Drawings and Sculptures Show Animals in War Zones

An exhibit of drawings of "Animals from the War Zones of the World" by Miss Mary Cecil and several pieces of sculpture by Miss Rhys Caparn on the same subject will open today in the Heads and Horns Museum Gallery at the New York Zoological Park. The exhibit will continue until Feb. 1.

Miss Allen and Miss Caparn have been making study sketches and drawings at the Bronx Zoo for a year, each for her particular type of work, when they discovered that virtually all of their drawings were of animals from regions of the world now at war. They made sketches of bears from Russia, giant pandas from China, a sladang from Malaysia, park cattle from England, a gayal from India, and a whole series of drawings of kangaroos from Australia.
